You and your contestants are invited to the Elkins Math/Science Competition on **January 18, 2020**. Number Sense, Calculator Applications, General Mathematics and Science will be offered. The fee is \$5.00 per student per event entered if the website is used to register.

**Walk-ins on the day of the competition will be accepted, but the cost will be \$10 per test.**

While late registration will be accepted on the day of the contest, you are urged to register before January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to enable us to make adequate plans. If you decide to make any changes to your registration after submission, please fill out the contact form on the website to let us know, and please also have your updated list of contestants with you on the day of the contest. An important note: Per FBISD, personal checks will no longer be accepted for payment. **Only school and/or district checks will be accepted for payment.** Cash payment will be accepted. District/school checks should be made out to **Elkins Activity Fund**. Competition will be by grade level and the tests will be provided by **TMSCA**.

Individual trophies will be awarded as follows:

- Top **ten** winners in all events for grades 3-5 (Elementary School Division)
- Top **ten** winners in all events for grades 6-8 (Middle School Division)
- Top **six** winners in all events for grades 9-12 (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> will get trophies, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> will get medals)

First, second and third place team trophies per event, as well as first, second and third place sweepstakes trophies will be given similar to the **TMSCA guidelines**. For High School, top biology, chemistry and physics will be awarded in addition to the other science trophies.
